Lampton Road site redevelopment and changes to pedestrian access routes

I wanted to let you know about changes in parking and the pedestrian access routes around the Civic Centre, which will come into effect from the end of June, and hope that you can share this with your pupils, staff and parents who use these paths to get to Lampton School.

In March, the council's Planning Committee approved plans for a new housing development on the current Civic Centre site in Lampton Road, and work is due to begin from the end of the month, with the first 160 homes to be completed in spring 2018 and the remainder – up to 780 – planned for completion in 2022.

The existing Civic Centre will be completely demolished to make way for the housing, and the council offices will move to a smaller and more cost-efficient new civic centre, incorporating a library and cafe, on the site of the current Bath Road car park at the end of Lampton Road.

To enable the works to begin, **hoardings will be going up around the front part of the Civic Centre site from Friday 24 June**, where the first phase of housing will be built.

The hoardings will encompass the area from Clovelly Road to the Civic Centre building, cross the front of the building and line the path between the main entrance and the bus stop by the entry to the multi storey car park (please see the attached map for full details). As part of these changes, staff and visitors' car parking will be relocated to the ground floor of the multi storey car park.

Pedestrian access from Lampton Road to the Civic Centre (and the pathway that runs behind the multi-storey car park towards Neville Close) will only be from the pathway by the bus stop near the entrance to the multi-storey car park. All other routes from the main road, including Clovelly Road, will no longer be available.

Once the hoardings go up, there will be construction traffic in and around the area. Therefore, to ensure the safety of any pupils, parents and staff who may use the

pathways across the Civic Centre site, I would ask that you inform them of the changes and recommend that anyone who currently uses the Civic Centre grounds uses alternative routes. In particular, I would ask you to discourage pupils from cutting through the car park, which is likely to be busy and in constant use by visitors.

Access along Lampton Road, and via Lampton Park along the path between the Civic Centre and the playing field, will be maintained.
